SUNDERLAND had a lot of problems against Luton Town at Roker Park this afternoon chiefly in troubling the Luton goalkeeper. Goalscoring is obviously going to be Sunderland's problem and there were few opportunities in a disappointing first half this afternoon.

Luton were always much more dangerous on the attack with Hatton creating a lot of trouble not only as a striker but with his clever use of the ball, too.

Argus reports from Roker Park

Sunderland relied upon the side which gave them a win over Stoke City on Tuesday night and retained Alan Brown as substitute. Luton's only change was the introduction of their beat-the-deadline signing from Southampton of Forbes Phillipson-Masters.

There were about 25,000 present when Sunderland started the game attacking the Fulwell End. Elliott covered up well when Hatton tried to make progress on the left and then Docherty gave a great through ball for Entwistle who was halted by Masters.

Luton made poor use of a free kick 25 yards out when Clarke was pulled up for a tackle from behind on Hatton.
