OTHER GOAL ATTEMPTS: Town five saved and seven off target; Cardiff two saved and six off target.

ATTENDANCE: 9,420, including two coach-loads who were up with the dawn chorus to arrive in time for the 11.30 am kick-off.

REFEREE: Alan Seville, Birmingham—both sides were critical of his performance, and the Town believed he robbed David Moss of a hat-trick of penalties.

BOOKINGS: Tony Grealish for dissent; John Buchanan of Cardiff after a dropped ball pantomime.

ENTERTAINMENT: Very good, with both sides playing positive soccer, and always trying to go forward. Some of the Town's quick-passing moves were lovely to watch, but needed a more emphatic conclusion in the box.
