

LUTON ROMP TO EASY HOME WIN

DESPITE missing a first half penalty Luton went on to take complete control — and the points — from this game.

The missed penalty, in the 29th minute, came when Chris Turner made a good save from Brian Stein's kick.

The second half, however, was full of goals with the first arriving a minute after the resumption when Ricky Hill took advantage of David Moss's cross.

Twelve minutes later the Town increased their lead when Paul Walsh beat two defenders after taking full advantage of a

neat one-two with Brian Horton.

But those two goals stung Sunderland into action and they pulled one back through Colin West in the 67th minute.

The Town, however, quickly restored their two goal advantage three minutes later when Iain Munro completely deceived his own keeper with an intended back pass.

Six minutes later Luton hit their fourth when Stein gleefully headed Moss's cross into the net for his first goal of the season.
