

HUNT-ED DOWN

SUBSTITUTE Andy Hunt launched a second half smash and grab raid to keep Albion in the promotion frame.

He turned the game around after Luton had looked like snatching the win they needed to escape bottom spot.

In the first half Luton were looking comfortable after Richard Harvey had fired them into a 19th-minute lead.

and Albion never looked back.

First Hunt laid on a pass for Stacy Coldicott to shoot and Albion were convinced they had scored, but the referee ruled that Ian Feuer had scrambled it off the line.

Two minutes later Albion's anger vanished when Hunt put Kevin Donovan away

down the right. He hit a pinpoint cross for Lee Ashcroft to head the equaliser.

Then keeper Stuart Naylor came to Albion's rescue, diving to his right to save a penalty by Steve Davis after Marshall was brought down.

And as Luton heads dropped Hunt finished them off with an 83rd minute winner created by Donovan and Shaun Cunnington.

But Albion's delight will be tempered as Paul Agnew was stretchered off with what may be a serious knee injury.
