

Defence stands firm

AFTER playing tremendous football in the first half at Edgeley Park, the Town had to show the battling side of their abilities to save a point in the second.

Stockport were played off the park for 45 minutes, with Ceri Hughes and Gary Waddock dominating midfield, and Graham Alexander and Paul Showler providing attacking width.

Steve Davis headed the opening goal from a 26th-minute corner by Alexander. Kim Grant missed a couple of decent chances, but in the second half it was the Town's turn to suffer as Stockport started to get their game together.

A series of four corners in quick succession, won by sweat and endeavour rather than flair, led to Brett Angell diving into a ruck to head the equaliser.

Town teams of the recent past would have caved in after that, because Stockport played with remarkable passion and commitment.

But the defence steadied, and when real danger threatened Ian Feuer made a brilliant save from Angell.
