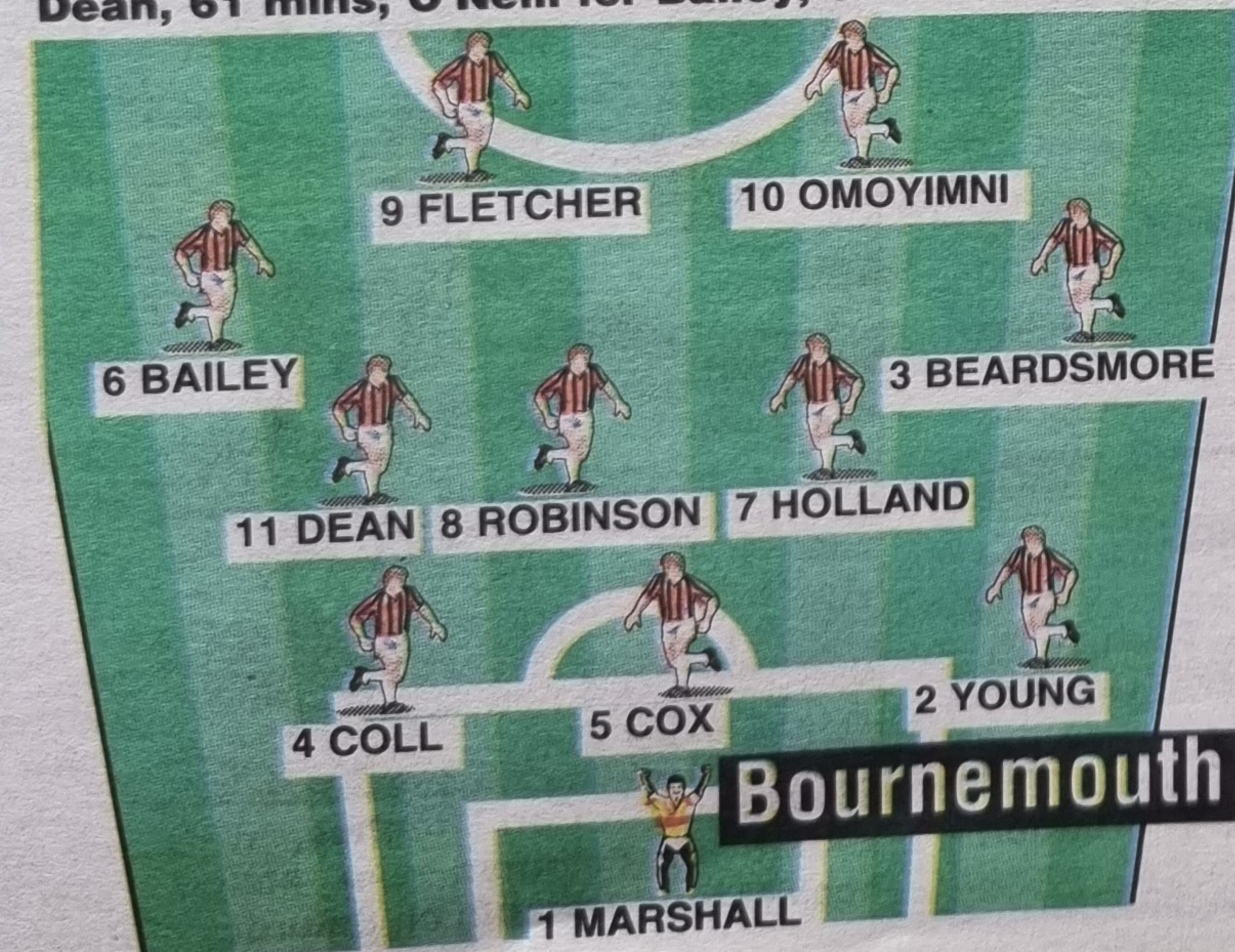


Luton Town
