GOALS: 0-1 59 mins: Terry Robbins after Ian Feuer advanced to confront Tony Samuels and was bypassed by a square ball inside;

1-1 66 mins: Dwight Marshall, thanks to electric pace and expert low drive after Feuer's punted clearance took a lucky bounce off the back of Billy Harrigan's head;

2-1 83 mins: Marshall again, another low shot through a crowded penalty area from a deep free kick by Ceri Hughes and a knock-down header by Darren Patterson, who was deputising for injured Marvin Johnson.

OTHER ATTEMPTS: Town three saved and five wide; Boreham Wood one saved and three wide.

CORNERS: 8-4 to Boreham Wood.

FOULS: Town 9, Boreham Wood 13.

OFFSIDE: Town 4 times, Boreham Wood 6.

BOOKED: Graham Alexander for pointless dissent over a corner not being given by a linesman; Ceri Hughes for a foul; Boreham Wood's Steve Heffer and Tony Joyce for wasting time by kicking the ball away when free kicks were awarded to the Town.

REFEREE: Barry Knight, Orpington. Handled the game well.

ATTENDANCE: 5,332, with about 1,000 supporting the non-league visitors.
