THE GOAL: Andrew Fotiadis, 53 minutes, at the second attempt, converting a low cross from David Oldfield at the end of one of the best moves of the match.

OTHER ATTEMPTS: Town six saved and three wide; Peterborough seven saved and five wide.

FOULS: Town eight, Peterborough nine.

OFFSIDE: Town four times, Peterborough ten.

BOOKED: Ceri Hughes for a foul on Wayne Bullimore.

REFEREE: Barry Knight, Orpington. Was given a very easy game by two teams trying to play football. The linesmen tried to compensate by erratic and often late application of the offside laws.

ATTENDANCE: 9,499, easily Peterborough's best of the season, with the Town taking the biggest away following London Road has seen, 3,400.

ENTERTAINMENT: Another 'never mind the quality, feel the result' day. Top quality soccer it was not, but all that mattered to both teams was the points and the Town's battling display deserved them.
