

Blackpool floored by late strikes

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LUTON scored twice in the last eight minutes to spoil Steve McMahon's home debut and leave the Seasiders deep in relegation trouble.

Blackpool looked to be cruising to their first win since November until Phil Gray headed home a Matthew Spring corner on 82 minutes.

Then deep into injury time Matthew Taylor volleyed home from 25 yards past an unsighted Tony Caig to stun the home fans.

Pool had got off to a flyer when Gary Ablett headed home a cross from fellow debutante Kevin Richardson.

Adam Locke equalised with a superb individual goal on 27 minutes but second-half goals from Phil Clarkson on 47 minutes and then Steve Bushell put the Seasiders in control until their late heart-breaking collapse.
