Luton responded with a stinging Matthew Spring drive that Macho gathered on the second attempt but the home side went in at the break trailing 5-0 on aggregate.

The Hatters continued to look for a goal after the interval and McLaren should have netted his side a consolation on 54 minutes but somehow contrived to send a diving header wide from two yards out.

Thomson then shot wide after team-mate Tresor Kandol obstructed his route to goal following Taylor's excellent cross to the far post.

On 69 minutes, George dragged an effort wide from the edge of the box and McLaren missed another sitter shortly afterwards when he side-footed off target from six yards.

Macho saved a curling 20-yard George effort after 78 minutes before Kandol finally gave Hatters the consolation goal they deserved when he headed in Spring's corner at the far post.
