Scott Canham missed an excellent third minute chance when he headed wide from close range.

Orient skipper Dean Smith was equally as wasteful from six yards moments later.

Crowe's curling shot was the Hatters first effort on target after 35 minutes but was comfortably saved by Scott Barrett.

The Orient keeper was beaten seconds later when Nugent's free-kick from the right found Coyne at the far post and he volleyed into the bottom corner from 10 yards.

The Hatters doubled the lead in the 49th minute when a relieved Crowe ended his 10-game goal drought.

Luton made the points safe in the 66th minute when Valois's corner was half-cleared and Crowe's controlled hook back into the box found Forbes, who gathered the ball before driving low past Barrett.
