

Bennett cuts off Luton run

LEEDS goalkeeper Ian Bennett wiped out Luton's remarkable run of scoring in every one of their last 25 matches.

He pulled off a stunning one-handed fingertip save to stop Luton captain Kevin Nicholls from netting a 72nd-minute winner.

But Bennett could not wipe the smile off the face of Luton boss Mike Newell whose side top the Championship after this result.

Newell said: 'I'm not unhappy with the draw but my lads are very disappointed. That shows how hungry they are.'

Leeds boss Kevin Blackwell was pleased to take away a point saying: 'We knew they would be tough.'

Southampton manager Harry Redknapp told me his side were surprised at the level of Luton's play and their tenacity.'

Blackwell's strikers were largely nullified by emerging central defender Curtis Davies, the 20-year-old voted the best player in League One last season.
