LUTON SLIDE IS GROUNDS **FOR DISMAY**

MIKE NEWELL says the supporters deserve a new stadium - and that's why they have stood by him at the end of a rocky week.

Last week's Mad Hatter was on his best behaviour after the dual onslaught on chairman Bill Tomlins

and female match officials which saw him (Cool снатрольно "severely reprimanded" by the board.

But the long-running stadium issue - which saw Loyal Luton Supporters Club members handing out flyers calling for Tomlins to quit won't go away until the bulldozers move in.

Luton had a spell of pressure in the run-up to half-time, with Derby keeper Stephen Bywater saving from Adam Boyd and Leon Barnett, but for the rest of the match they were outplayed.

The second half one-way traffic, Derby took the lead with a cracker from Jonathan Stead, who cut in from the left touchline and beat two defenders before unleashing a low shot from 20 yards.

And it was all over two minutes later when Luton old boy Steve Howard (above) - who joined the Rams in the summer for £1million. lashed home after a clev-erly worked free-kick.

Howard, who barely celebrated his goal, said: "I knew what I'd done when I scored but I was never going to celebrate. It wasn't the right time or the right place. It's a bad run they're on but they'll turn it around "
