CALVIN Andrew's first goal of the season saw League One strugglers Luton salvage an FA Cup first round replay with a draw against League Two Brentford.

Substitute Andrew fired home from close-range 11 minutes from time after Darren Currie's shot from the right had ricocheted into his path.

Charlie Ide had given the Bees a deserved lead in the 20th-minute when he hooked home from 12 yards after Lee Thorpe's knockdown for his first of the campaign.

Luton, who saw leading goalscorer Paul Furlong hobble off after just five minutes, missed a glorious chance to level when David Edwards side-footed wide from eight yards out in the 27th-minute.

Jaroslav Fojut was stretchered off for the hosts after the interval and Brentford then saw Glenn Poole and Sammy Moore both go close.

But as the visitors sat back, Luton stepped up a gear and Steve Robinson, Currie and Matty Spring all drew saves from Simon Brown before Andrew found the net.

Brentford boss Terry Butcher said: "It was a very pleasing performance. I'm very proud of the players, the club and the fans."

Luton assistant boss Sam Ellis said: "Brentford played well in the first half, but I felt we had chances in the first and second."
