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



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

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# bring me sunshine

**DURING** the home game with Derby in 1981, ace winger David Moss, pictured below left, kicked the corner flag instead of the ball and to compound his embarrassment he had to call on the services of physio John Sheridan before he could continue.

**On December 28, 1999, Bristol City's match programme (see left) listed Tony Thorpe as playing for both sides! He had been on loan at Luton but went back before Christmas.**

**FOLLOWING** the Town's Littlewoods Cup final win over Arsenal in 1988 a well oiled Luton supporter decided to listen to the club's 'Soccer Line' before going off to sleep in his London hotel. When he awoke the following morning he was several hundred pounds worse off as he had drifted off before replacing the receiver!

**AT** Doncaster in 1967, the Town had to borrow a yellow kit from Watford as their first strip of white and second strip of red clashed with that of Rovers.

... a light-hearted dip in to the Kenilworth Road archives

**In 1973, when the Hatters were due to be playing Sheffield Wednesday at Hillsborough, the coach driver took them to Bramall Lane, home of Sheffield United.**

**During the very bad winter of 1962/63 the Hatters did not play a home league game between Boxing Day and March 16.**



**GROUNDS FOR CONCERN:** Luton's coach driver once took them to Bramall Lane, above, rather than Hillsborough



**With Manchester City beating the Hatters 6-2 in an FA Cup match at Luton in 1961 rain, which had been falling all day, turned torrential, leaving the referee no option but to call the players off the pitch. A few minutes later, with the rain easing, the referee went into the Luton dressing room to call the team back out. Showing admirable speed of thought, however, the players were already in the bath, leaving the referee little choice but to abandon the match. Town won 3-1 in the rearranged game.**

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



LET'S not beat about the bush, much-travelled striker Ian Benjamin was rubbish.


He joined the Hatters on November 20, 1992 and his eye for goal now makes Warren Feeney look like the next Thierry Henry.

Benji cost the club £50,000 – expensive at half the price – especially as he was shunted between 12 different teams during his playing days and didn't command a fee in the majority of these transfers.

His inclusion in this feature may seem a little harsh in some

fans' eyes – particularly as he netted in his second game for Hatters in a Sky-televised match against arch rivals Watford and also bagged a reasonable 130ish career goals in more than 550 matches.

When Ian scored against the Hornets with an awkward, twisting, diving header which just about dribbled over the line, supporters hoped the striker would go on to be a Luton legend. But it all went horribly wrong and he went on to score just one more goal in 11 appearances during his brief stay.

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

"On the way we stopped beside a field and stole a sheep that was


minding her own business, threw her in the back of the van and then drove on home for a sleep.

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
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
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


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
