In 1973, when the Hatters were due to be playing Sheffield Wednesday at Hillsborough, the coach driver took them to Bramall Lane, home of Sheffield United.

During the very bad winter of 1962/63 the Hatters did not play a home league game between Boxing Day and March 16.

beating the Hatters 6-2 in an FA Cup
match at Luton in 1961 rain, which had
been falling all day, turned torrential,

dressing room to call the team back out. Showing
admirable speed of thought, however, the
players were already in the bath, leaving the
referee little choice but to abandon the
match. Town won 3-1 in the
rearranged game.

LET'S not beat about the bush, much-travelled striker lan Benjamin was rubbish.


He joined the Hatters on November 20, 1992 and his eye for goal now makes Warren Feeney look like the next Thierry Henry.


Benji cost the club £50,000 – expensive at half the price – especially as he was shunted between 12 different teams during his playing days and didn't command a fee in the majority of these transfers.

His inclusion in this feature may seem a little harsh in some

fans' eyes – particularly as he netted in his second game for Hatters in a Sky-televised match against arch rivals Watford and also bagged a reasonable 130ish career goals in more than 550 matches.

When lan scored against the Hornets with an awkward, twisting, diving header which just about dribbled over the line, supporters hoped the striker would go on to be a Luton legend. But it all went horribly wrong and he went on to score just one more goal in 11 appearances during his brief stay.




