



WHAT a great start to the season with Town sitting pretty at the top of the table (at the time of writing anyway...). Clever passer Adam Murray would partner Keith Keane as he returns from suspension in the middle. Barnes-Homer has been on fire so far (apart from the penalty miss) with Gallen a useful foil up front alongside him.

If we don't get out of this league this season, we never will.



August 30, 1975 **Luton Town 3** Chelsea 0

THE Town had been relegated from Division One alongside Chelsea at the end of the previous campaign and with both sides tipped for a swift return to the top flight an early season clash was seen to be a strong pointer.
