






Howells should deputise at left full-back, alongside usual suspects Kroca, Pilks and Gleeson.





Blast from the past

points at

Millwall

Roger Wash looks back to see how the Town fared on this day in years gone by

December 18 1996 Millwall O Luton 1

Following relegation from the old Division Two (now the Championship) in 1996 the Town found the adjustment to life in the third tier particularly hard.

The first three games were all lost and the doom-mongers at Kenilworth Road were all predicting another season of struggle but gradually the players lifted themselves up by the bootstraps and started climbing the table.

A 6-0 home win over highly fancied Crewe.



with Tony Thorpe netting a hat-trick, on December 14 pushed the Town up to third spot adding spice to the visit to second placed Millwall four days later.

The Town had vet to win at the New Den and a crowd of 7,077 gathered to make sure the run continued.

It was the Hatters. though, who were

quickest out of the blocks with top scorer Thorpe spurning a good opportunity when firing wastefully over from ten yards.

Millwall huffed and puffed but could not find a way of breaking through the Town's offside trap and instead resorted to tough, uncompromising play in an attempt to rattle the Hatters.

With 17 minutes to go the Town appeared to have broken the stalemate when full-back Julian James hammered in a rocket which beat the goalkeeper but rebounded off the

post with no-one alert enough to apply the finishing touch.

The game seemed to be drifting to a 0-0 draw when, with 50 seconds to go, Ceri Hughes dispossessed Millwall's David Sinclair and fired in a shot from the edge of the area which squeezed into the far corner of the net.

Millwall did not have time to mount another attack and when the final whistle went the Town sat proudly on top of the table – a suitable present for manager Lennie Lawrence celebrating his first year in charge of the Hatters.


