... a word from the editor

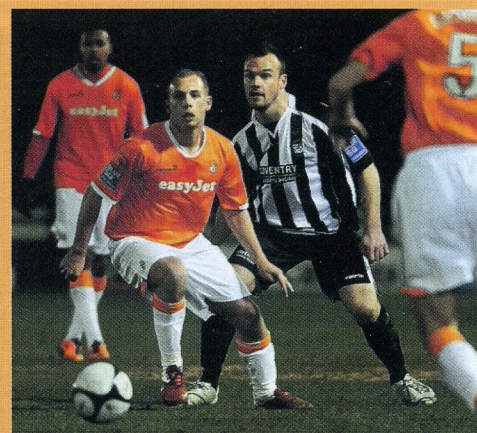
THE business end of the season. Don't you just love it?

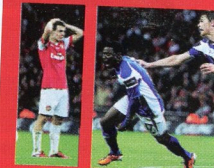
What d'ya mean you don't like it? Get a goal yourself and we'll see if you can do a better celebration.

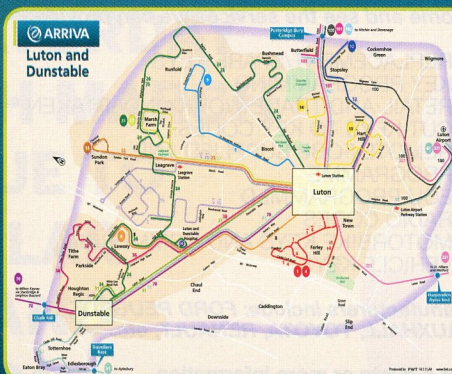

Obviously there are fears.

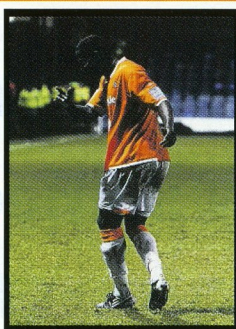
Cambridge United lost twice in the play-off final and have now become mediocre at best, relegation candidates at worst.

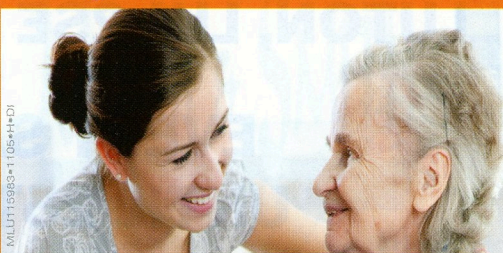

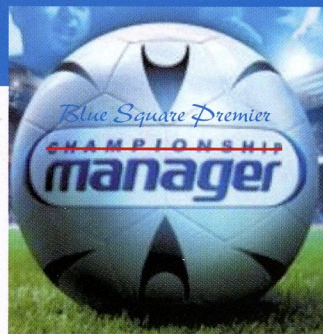

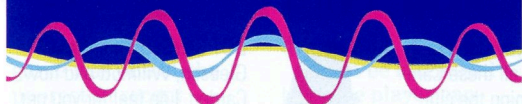

# Blast from the past

Roger Wash looks back to see how the Town fared on this day in years gone by

**March 5, 1977**

## Luton Town 2 Wolves 0

FOLLOWING a defeat at Orient on Boxing Day 1976 the Town had dropped down to 14th spot in the old Division Two and looked set for a season of mediocrity or perhaps even worse.

What transformed the team is difficult to lay a finger on but a run of seven straight wins sent the Hatters shooting up the table and supporters suddenly had the smell of promotion.

The visit of second-placed Wolves, who had gone 12 games undefeated, to Kenilworth Road was sure to be a test for the resurgent Hatters and 19,200 turned up to see which run was about to end.

Wolves were anxious

for a quick return to Division One and overwhelmed the Town in the opening minutes.

Gradually, the Luton defence took control with Paul Futcher and John Faulkner snuffing out the dangerous Wolves strikeforce of John Richards and Alan Sunderland, while Brian Chambers and Lil Fuccillo cut out the threat posed by Willie

Carr and Kenny Hibbitt.

This left Alan West free to carry out his own probing for the Town with the result that forwards Jim Husband, John Aston and Ron Futcher, constantly interchanged positions.

The breakthrough came after 35 minutes when Futcher rose to head on a free-kick from full-back Steve Buckley, with Husband first to

react with a crisp half-volley past Gary Pierce in the Wolves goal.

Incredibly, the Town went 2-0 up 90 seconds later when Fuccillo, in a seemingly harmless position out on the wing, drifted inside with the ball and casually floated the ball over the head of Pierce.

The crowd went wild and although Wolves stepped up the pressure after the break it was the Town who came nearest to scoring when Geoff Palmer threw himself full length to turn a shot from Futcher round the post with his hand which went unnoticed by the referee.

Despite this, and with some fine saves by Milija Aleksic in the Luton goal, Town found themselves up to fourth and putting pressure on the leaders.

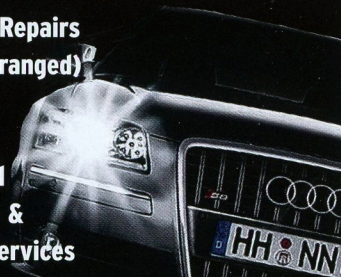

Mid-table obscurity beckons and a dozen fairly pointless end of season games with it. But as relegation certainties at the start of the season I think we'll take that.

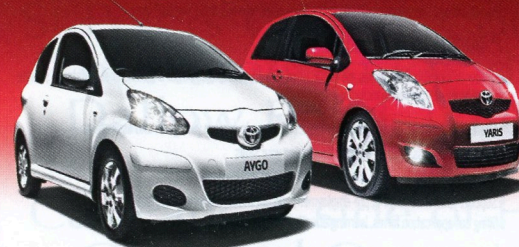
