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CLUB NOTES by "Hatter"

NOW what have we to say. The huge defeat at Chesterfield was a big set back and we have now conceded more goals than any other Club in the four divisions. Therefore our weakness is palpable and the defence which but two short seasons ago was nearly impenetrable has weakened considerably. Figures cannot lie, the forwards, no matter how often we have moaned and groaned anent some of their misses, have recorded more goals than any other team in the division, and whereas in the past, two or three goals by the vanguard has meant certain victory, this cannot be said so today. Just look at the results for the season, we have lost to Tottenham at home 2-4, Burnley away 2-3, drawn with West Ham at home 2-2, beat Southampton away 6-3, beat Plymouth away 4-2, beat Stockport at home 6-4, lost to Manchester United away 2-4, to Sheffield United at home 2-3, beat Bury away 4-3, beat Bradford at home 4-2, drew with Blackburn Rovers away 2-2, and with Sheffield Wednesday at home 2-2. It can be seen the forwards are thus doing their share. Last Saturday's defeat brought the shadow of relegation to our path and although I do not think for one moment we shall be forced to play Third Division football next term, still the fact remains we have landed ourselves in the danger zone and have to meet in our remaining opposition all clubs who have this boggy confronting them. A win therefore over any of them is as good as four points to us and as much as I should loathe to see Plymouth Argyle descend to the lower division I hope to record today our first victory since February 26th.

If the "Stiffs" did nothing else against Brentford Reserves last Saturday, they gave us a result we had not previously experienced on this ground, this season, a goalless draw. I thought they were rather unfortunate not to get both points, but Mathieson in the "Bees" goal played a great game. He made a great save from Fred Hogg soon after the game started, I do not remember seeing a better this season, but was a trifle fortunate on one or two occasions. Two come to my mind immediately, a

header from Horace Gager following a corner kick early on, and a shot from George Kidd late in the game following another assault. Mention of Horace Gager brings me to an appeal to all supporters. Why must the first mistake this local boy makes bring upon his head the ire and jeers of the supporters? I know this is much more apparent in the Mid-Week games, but this feeling could be sensed as well last Saturday. Surely it is much better to give a boy in his first term as a professional, especially with his own local club, all encouragement instead of criticism. Speaking personally I have more than once felt tempted to pick a row with certain spectators over this, what I call, unsportsmanlike attitude. Anyhow Horace my advice to you is to take no notice of it, just treat it with the contempt it deserves. I can assure you your club-mates are very sympathetic towards you in this matter and you have their confidence, which perhaps is better than anything else.

I find having written so far I have as yet to welcome our visitors Plymouth Argyle. It is exceedingly pleasing to make their acquaintance once again after a lapse of so many years, for the old Southern League and Third Division tussles were always games that live in memory. If my memory serves me correct the Argyle were always our boggy team in those days and our victory at Home Park earlier in the present season was the first ever recorded there. Even at Luton the Argyle were usually taking away one or two points, but let us hope both remain here today.
